# Caring for your furniture WOOD

With the right care you can prolong the life of your wooden furniture.

It is useful to have a regular maintenance routine and we can also help recommend specific cleaners and care packs for your dining table or cabinet.

Solid woods and wood veneers are a natural product and cared for correctly can last for generations to come. As it is a completely natural product, any shop floor product should be viewed as being 'indicative' of the colour and finish, however, we cannot guarantee an exact colour match.

Some of our furniture is also deliberately aged and rustic, this includes our reclaimed ranges which have been carefully crafted and retain the character of the timbers former use, such as nail holes. This type of product must be appreciated for its unique nature and variations in colour, natural inherent grains, marks, nail holes, saw marks etc are considered part of this type of products features and are in no way a fault.





All solid timber and veneer surfaces will change colour and mellow over time, this also means that new furniture will initially vary in shade from items that have been previously purchased.



Excessive exposure to sunlight can cause fading of your furniture.



Dust your furniture with a clean, damp, lint free cloth. Frequent dusting will remove abrasive build up, which can damage the finish over time.



Do not use a very wet cloth or allow any liquid to contact with the veneers for a long period of time as this can permanently damage the surface.



Wipe up spills immediately.



Do not use any abrasive cleaner or harsh detergent as this can damage the surface of the furniture.



Spray polishes are best avoided as they contain silicones which may spoil the furniture's surface when building up over time.



Make sure all surfaces are protected from heat and liquids by mats and coasters.



Ensure that a mat or pad is placed under paper when you are writing on the furniture surface.

As soon as you receive your furniture we recommend that you clean and protect as below and then continue to care for your product as follows:-

### Weekly Maintenance

use a soft non-abrasive cloth to remove dust (may be very lightly dampened with water)

### **Every 3-4 months**

use a recommended specialist cleaning solution to remove dirt and build up, then follow with a specialist conditioner to nourish and protect the wood.
